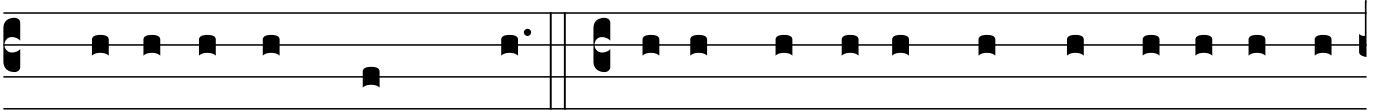

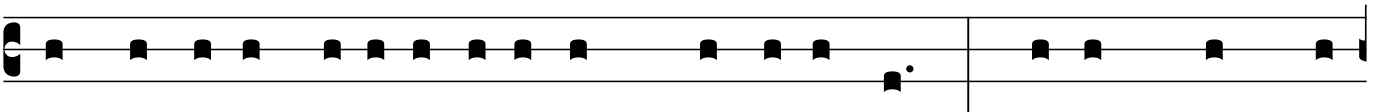

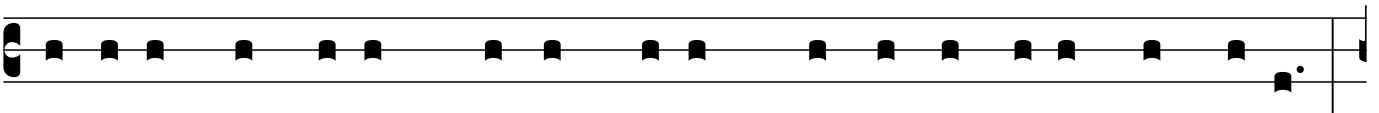
The Ho-ly Gos-pel of our Lord Je-sus Christ ac-cord-ing to John.



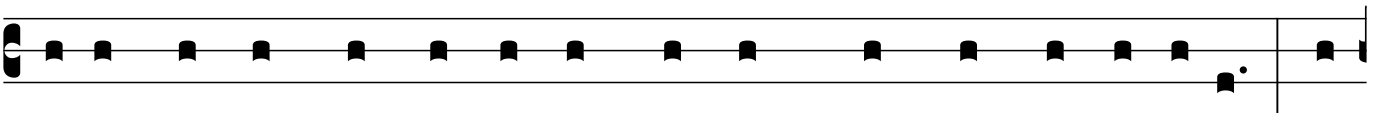
R *Glo-ry to you, Lord Christ.* After this Je-sus went to the other side



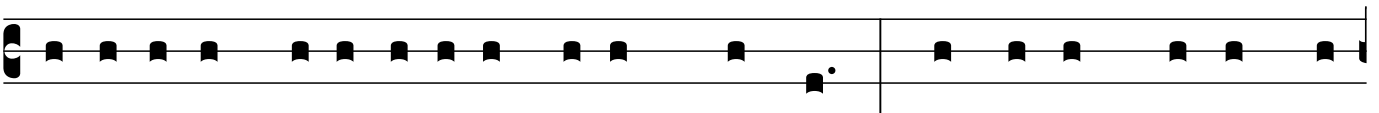
of the Sea of Gal-i-lee, also called the Sea of Tiberias. A large crowd kept



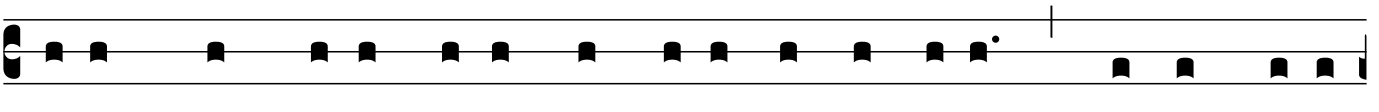
fol-lowing him because they saw the signs that he was do- ing for the sick.



Je-sus went up the mountain and sat down there with his dis-ci-ples. Now



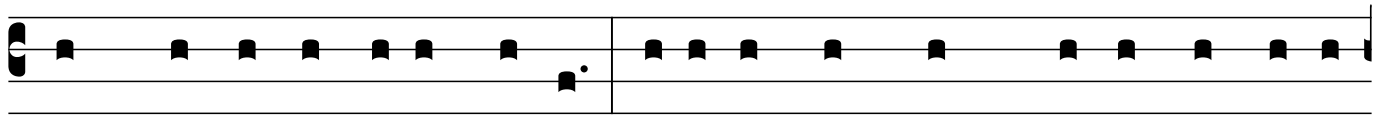
the Passo-ver, the fes-ti-val of the Jews, was near. When he looked up and saw



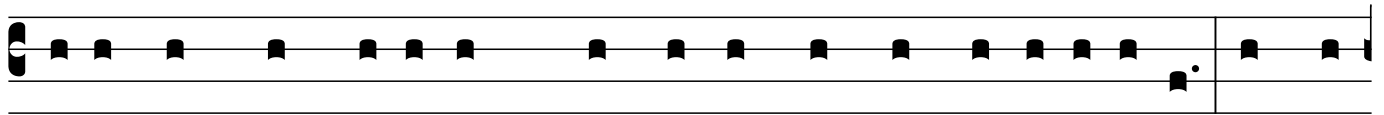
a large crowd coming toward him, Je-sus said to Phil- ip, “Where are we to



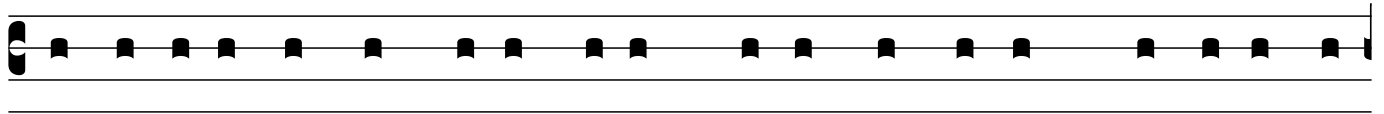
buy bread for these people to eat?” He said this to test him, for he himself



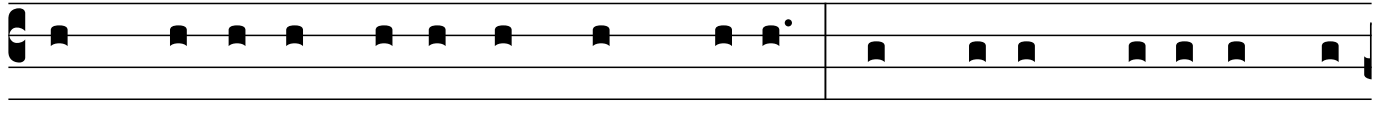
knew what he was go- ing to do. Phil- ip answered him, “Two hundred de-nar-



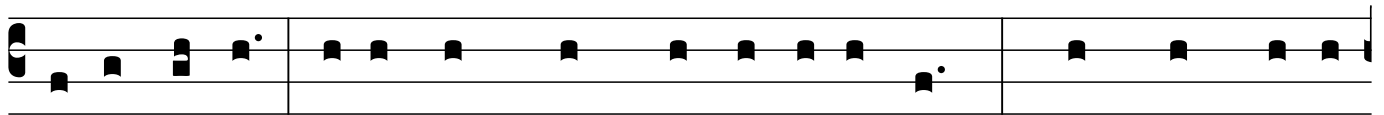
i- i would not buy enough bread for each of them to get a little.” One of



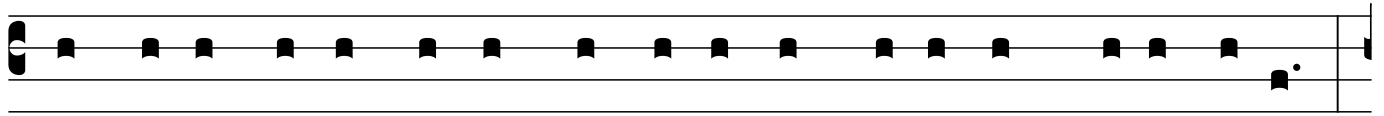
his dis-ciples, Andrew, Simon Pe-ter’s brother, said to him, “There is a boy



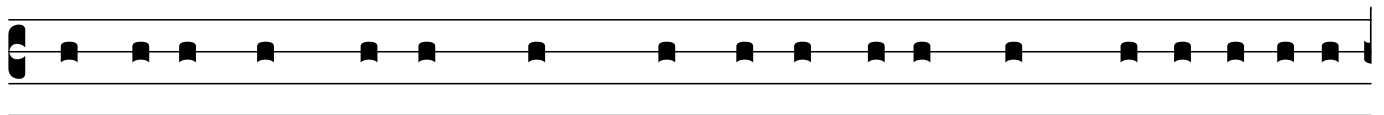
here who has five barley loaves and two fish. But what are they among so



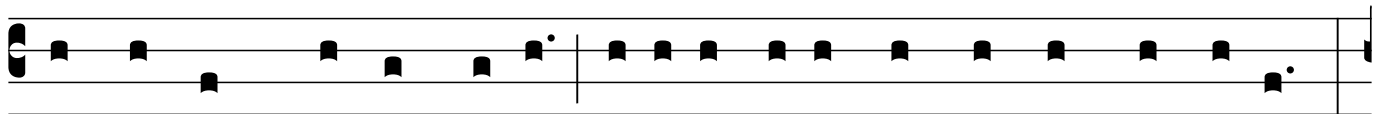
man-y people?” Je-sus said, “Make the people sit down.” Now there was a



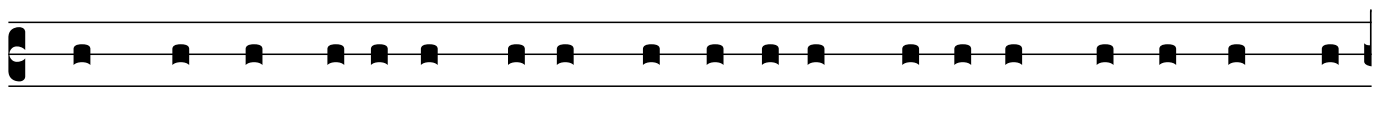
great deal of grass in the place, so they sat down, about five thousand in all.



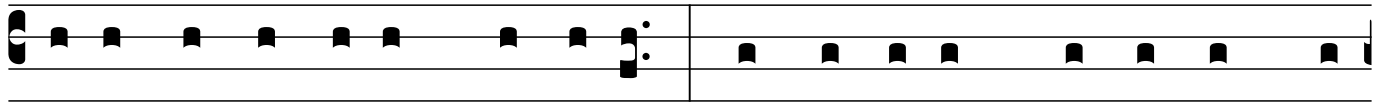
Then Je-sus took the loaves, and when he had giv-en thanks he distrib-ut-ed



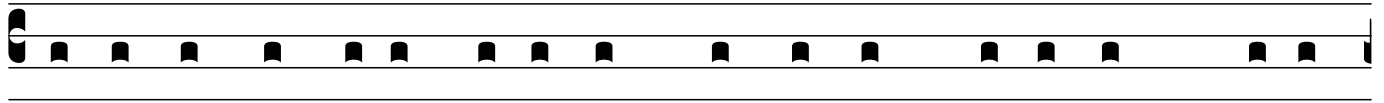
them to those who were seat-ed; so also the fish, as much as they wanted.



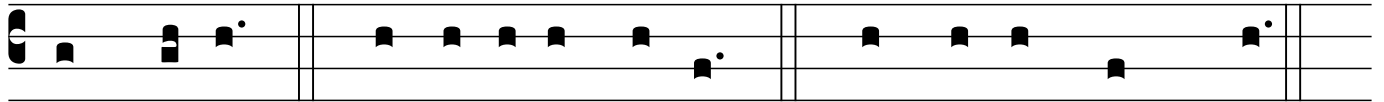
When they were sat-ised, he told his dis-ciples, “Gather up the fragments left
