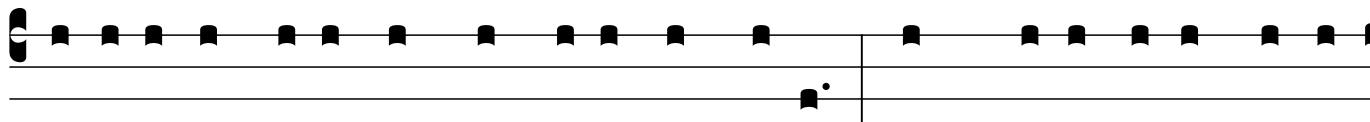
The Lord spoke to Mo-ses, say-ing, “Take Aaron and his sons with him,



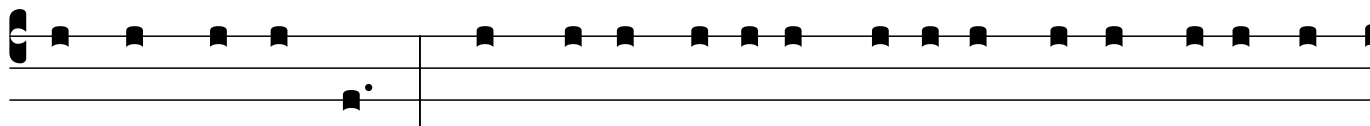
the vestments, the anointing oil, the bull for the purification offer-ing, the



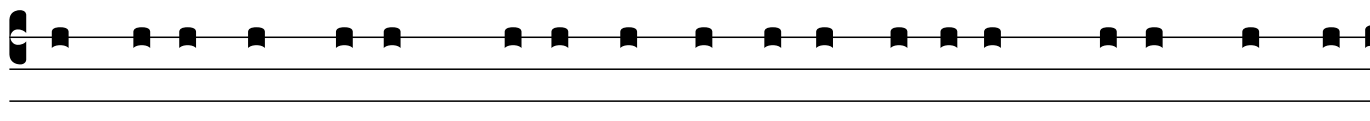
two rams, and the basket of unleavened bread; and assemble the whole con-



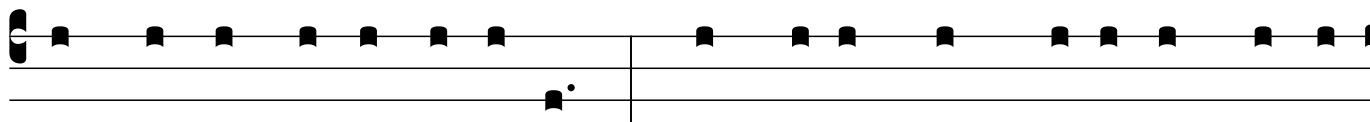
gre-gation at the entrance of the tent of meet-ing.” And Mo-ses did as the Lord



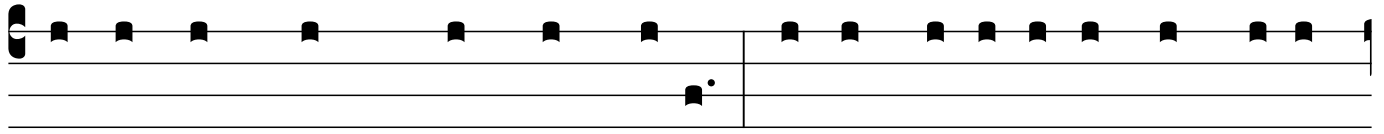
had commanded him. When the congre-gation was assembled at the entrance



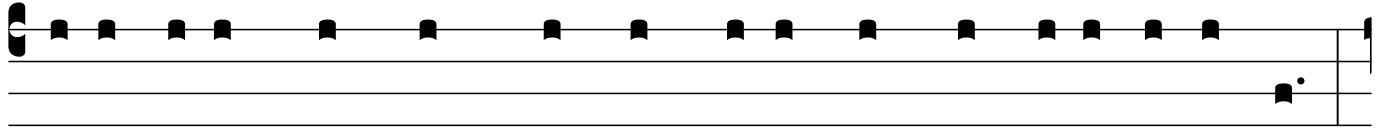
of the tent of meet-ing, Mo-ses said to the congre-gation, “This is what the



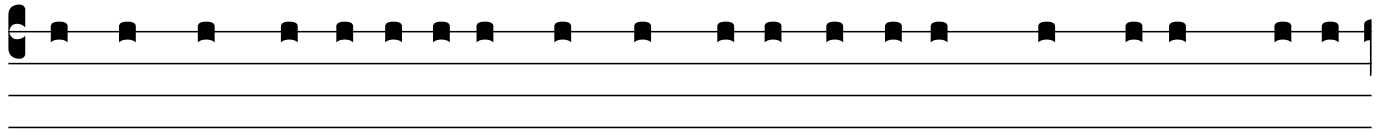
Lord has commanded to be done.” Then Mo-ses brought Aaron and his sons



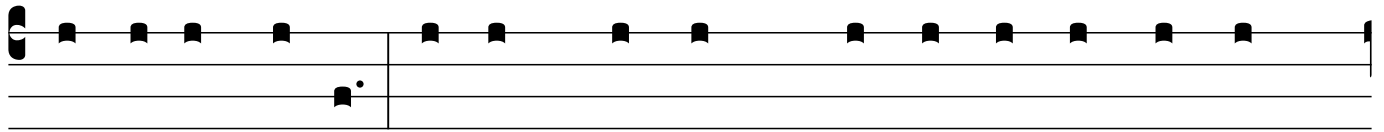
forward and washed them with wa-ter. He put the tu-nic on him, fastened



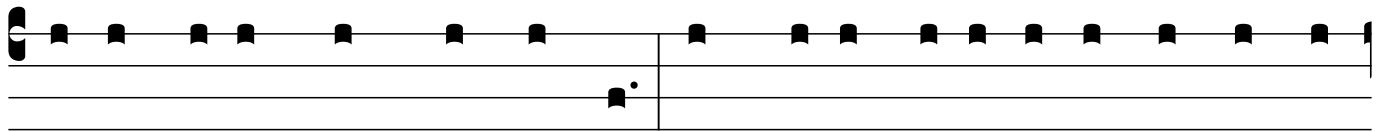
the sash around him, clothed him with the robe, and put the ephod on him.



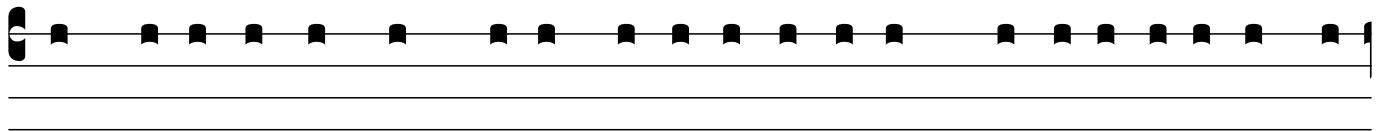
He then put the dec-o-rat-ed band of the ephod around him, ty- ing the e-



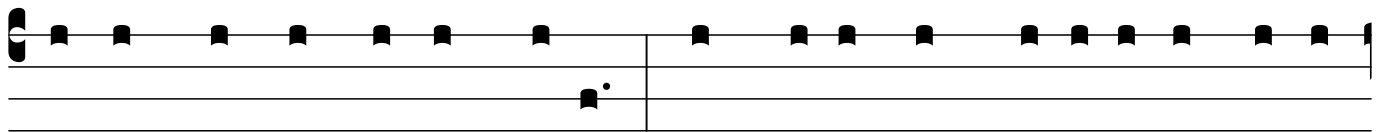
phod to him with it. He placed the breastpiece on him, and in the breastpiece



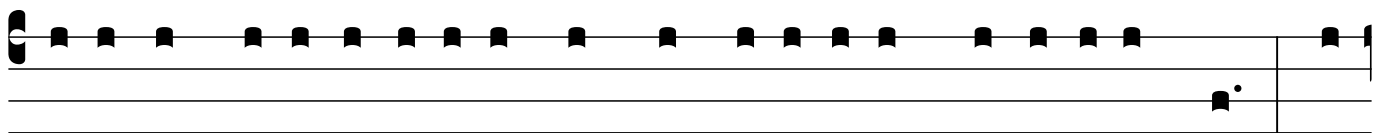
he put the Urim and the Thummim. And he set the turban on his head, and



on the turban, in front, he set the golden ornament, the ho-ly di- a-dem, as



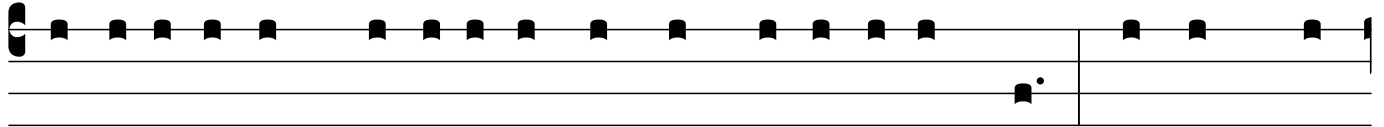
the Lord had commanded Mo-ses. Then Mo-ses took the anointing oil and



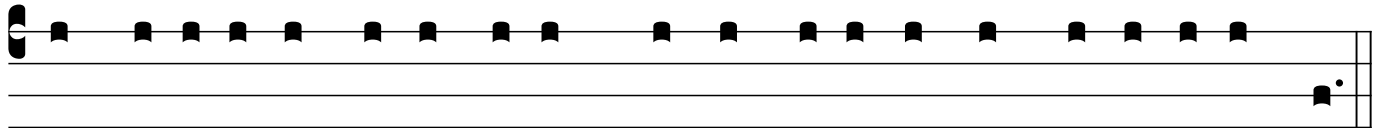
anointed the tab-ernacle and all that was in it and consecrat-ed them. He
