pa-tience, kindness, ho-li-ness of spir-it, gen-u-ine love, truthful speech, and



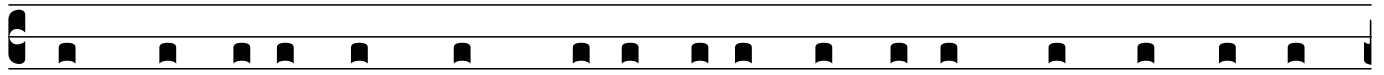
the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and



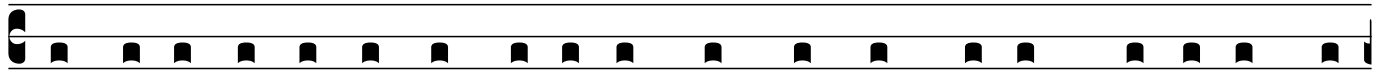
for the left; in hon-or and dishon-or, in ill re-pute and good re-pute.
