that they may o-pen the door for him as soon as he comes and knocks.

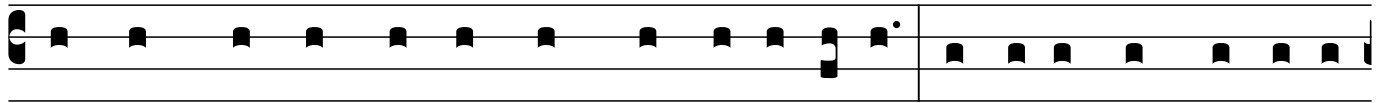
Blessed are those slaves whom the master finds a-lert when he comes; tru-ly

I tell you, he will fasten his belt and have them sit down to eat, and he

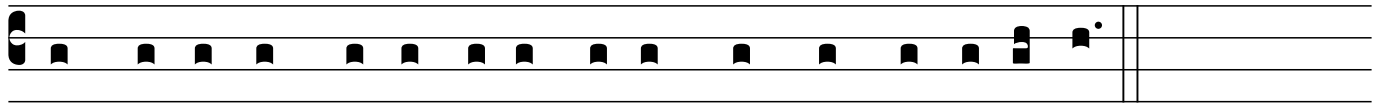
will come and serve them. If he comes dur-ing the middle of the night or
