


# Luke 6:17-26

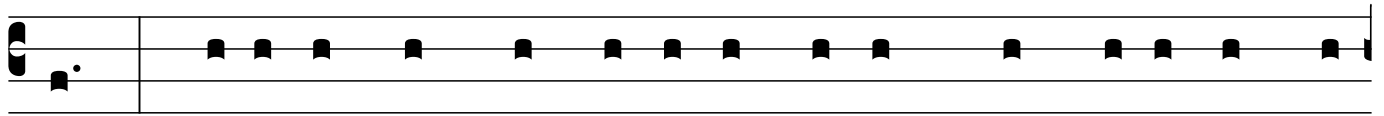

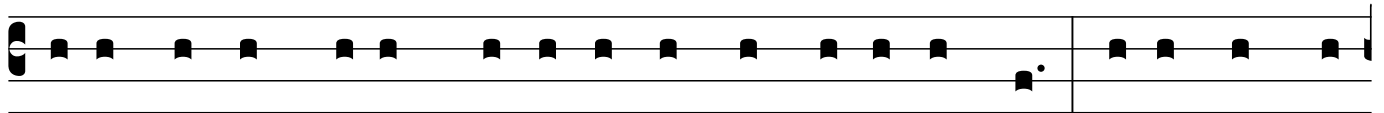

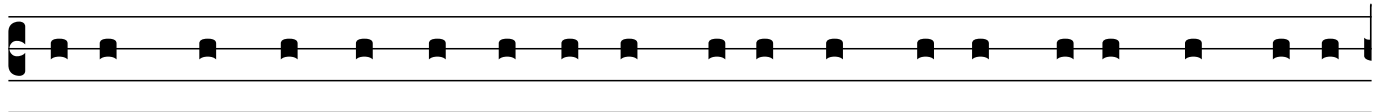
for you will be filled. “Blessed are you who weep now, for you will



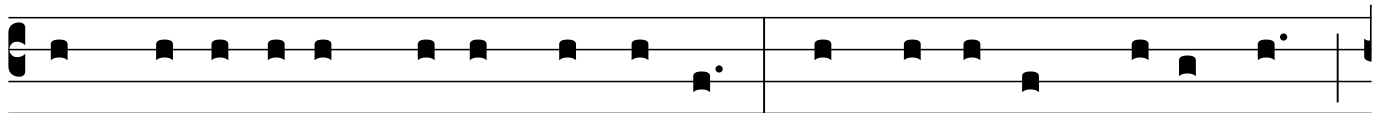
laugh. “Blessed are you when people hate you and when they exclude you,



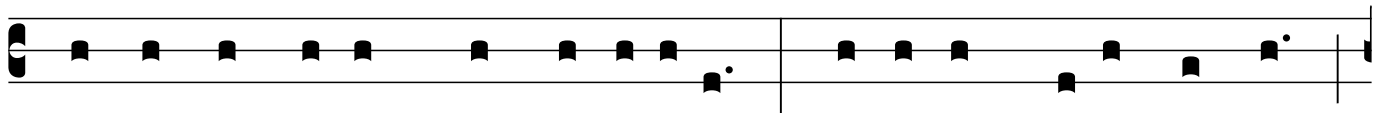
re-vile you, and de-fame you on account of the Son of Man. Re-joice on that



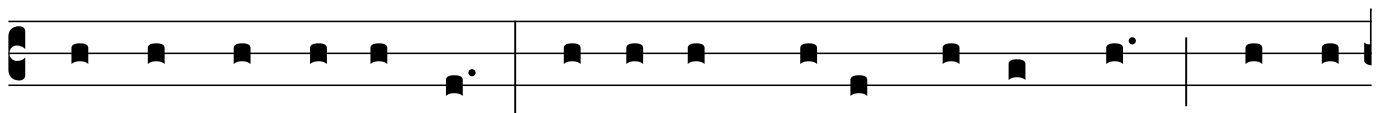
day and leap for joy, for surely your reward is great in heaven, for that is



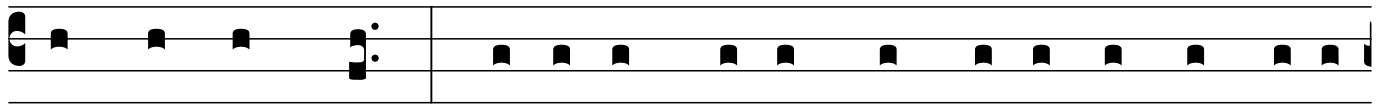
how their ancestors treat-ed the prophets. “But woe to you who are rich,



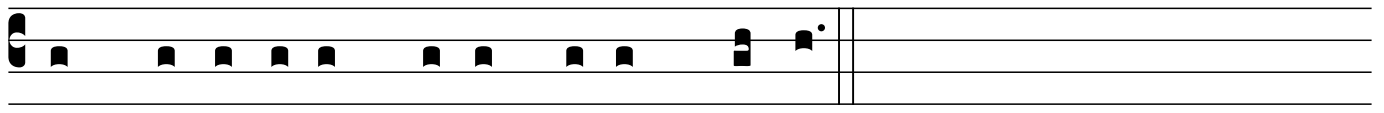
for you have re-ceived your conso-lation. “Woe to you who are full now,
