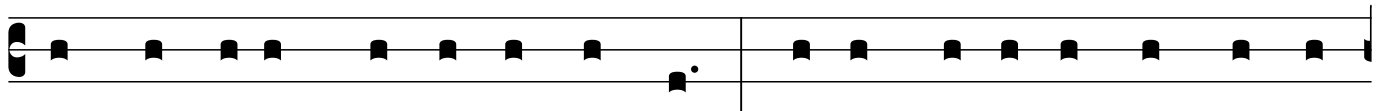
A dis-ciple is not a-bove the teacher nor a slave a-bove the master;



it is enough for the dis-ciple to be like the teacher and the slave like the



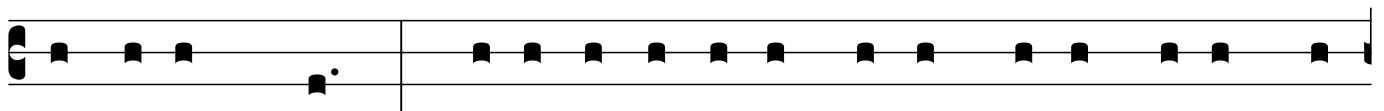
master. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebul, how much more



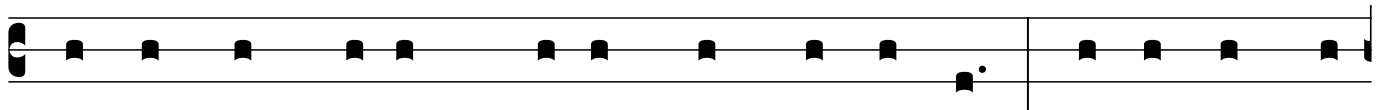
will they ma-lign those of his household! “So have no fear of them, for noth-



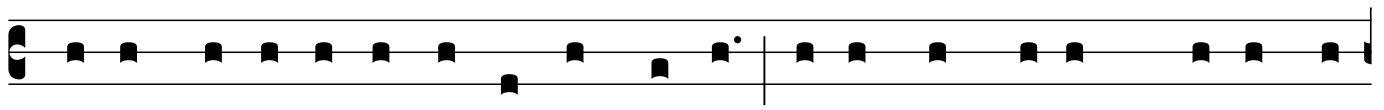
ing is cov-ered up that will not be uncov-ered and nothing secret that will



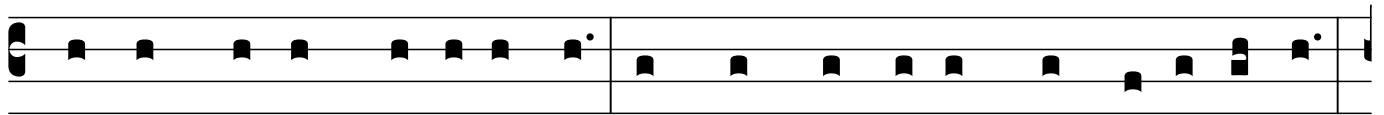
not be-come known. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the light, and



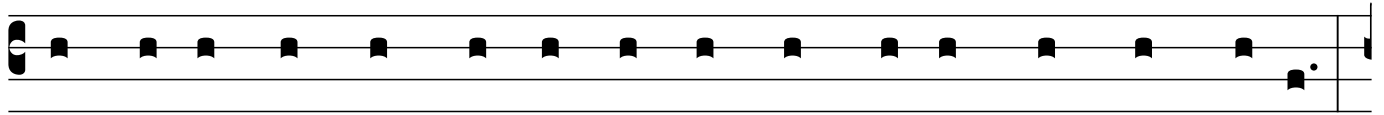
what you hear whispered, proclaim from the housetops. Do not fear those



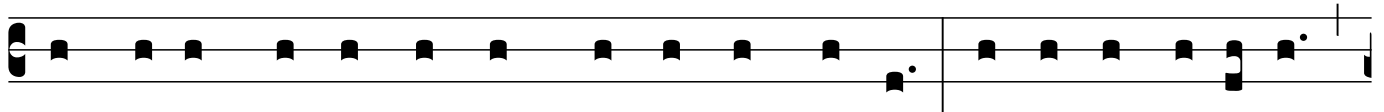
who kill the bod-y but cannot kill the soul; rather, fear the one who can de-



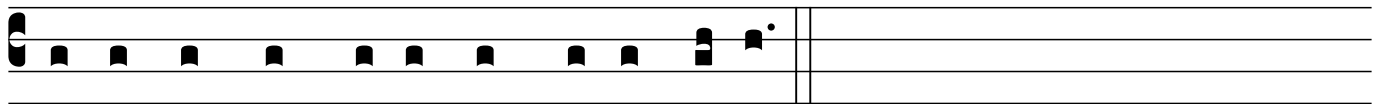
stroy both soul and bod-y in hell. Are not two sparrows sold for a penny?
