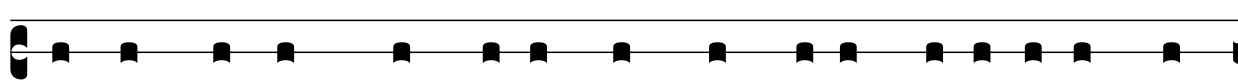

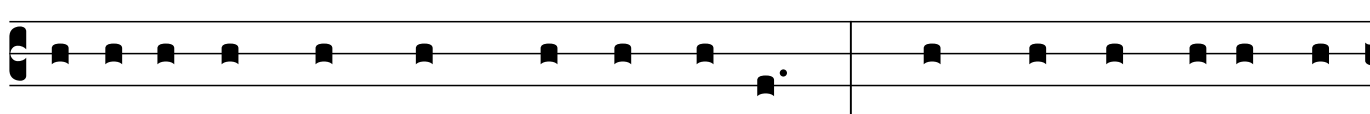

Emmaus, about sev-en miles from Je-ru-sa-lem, and talking with each oth-



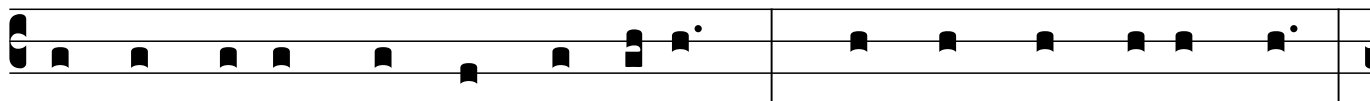
er about all these things that had happened. While they were talking and



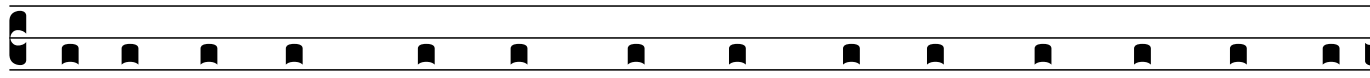
discussing, Je-sus himself came near and went with them, but their eyes were



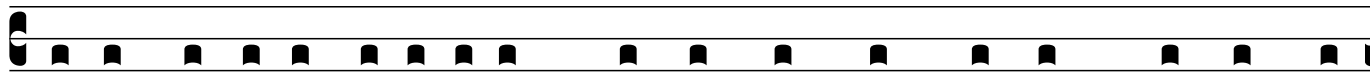
kept from rec-ogniz-ing him. And he said to them, “What are you discussing



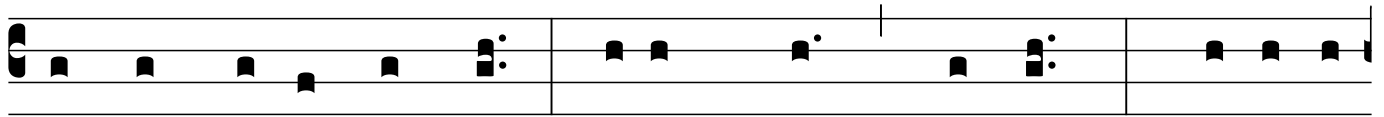
with each other while you walk a-long?” They stood still, looking sad.



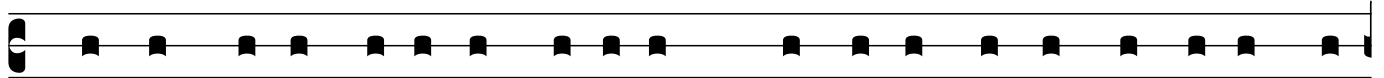
Then one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answered him, “Are you the



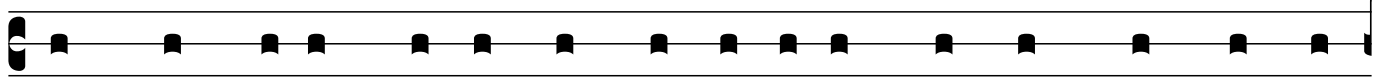
only stranger in Je-ru-sa-lem who does not know the things that have tak-



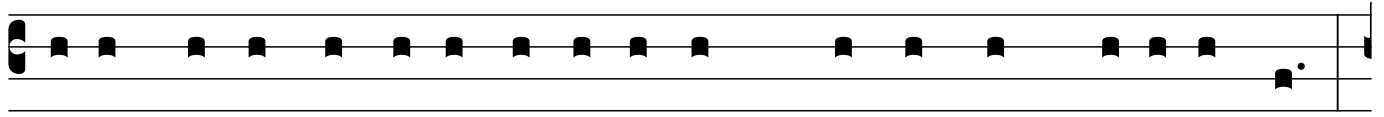
en place there in these days?” He asked them, “What things?” They replied,



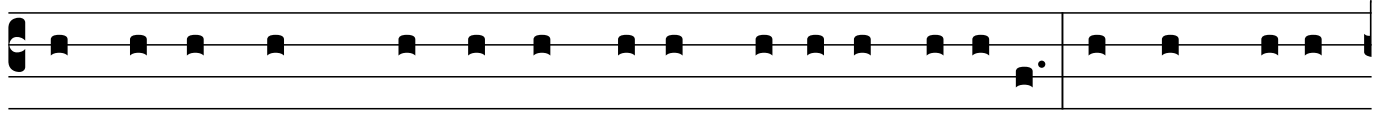
“The things about Je-sus of Naz-a-reth, who was a prophet mighty in deed



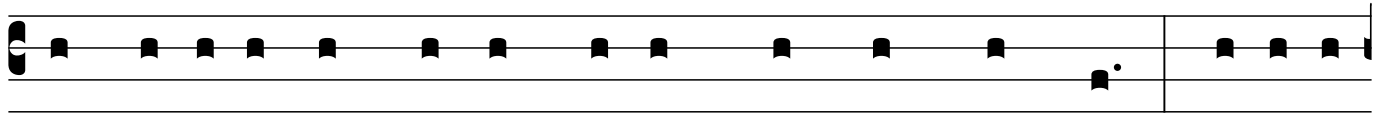
and word be-fore God and all the people, and how our chief priests and



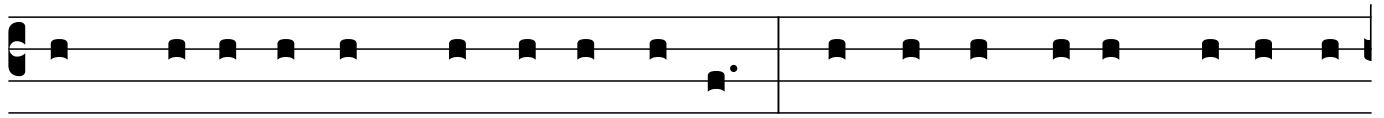
leaders handed him o-ver to be condemned to death and cru-ci-fied him.



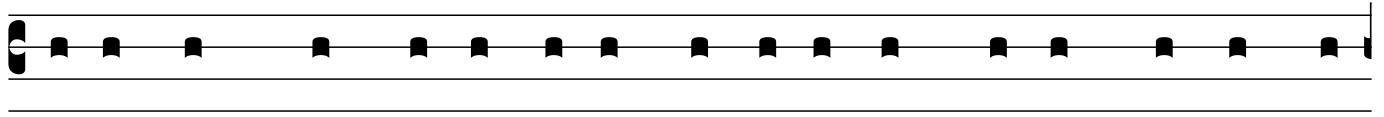
But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Isra-el. Yes, and be-sides



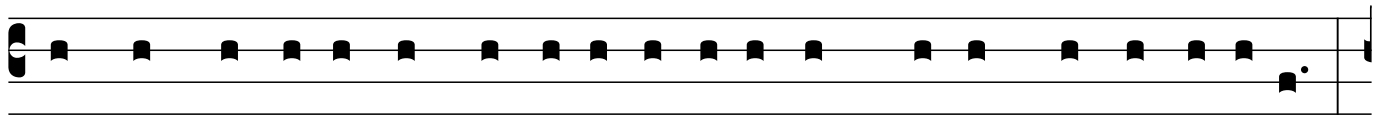
all this, it is now the third day since these things took place. Moreo-ver,



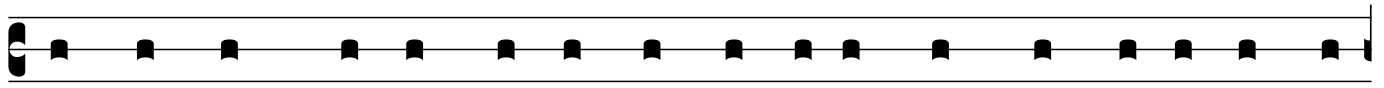
some women of our group astounded us. They were at the tomb early this



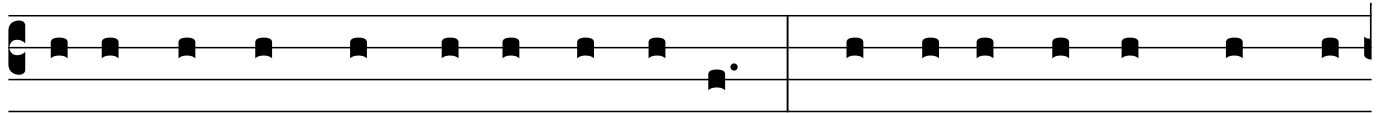
morning, and when they did not find his bod-y there they came back and told



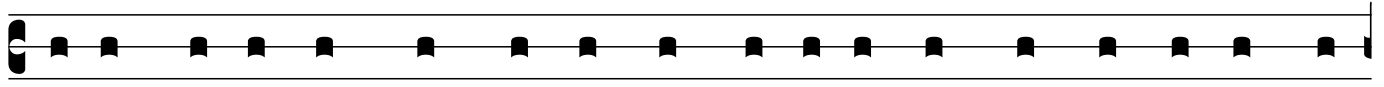
us that they had indeed seen a vi-sion of angels who said that he was a-live.



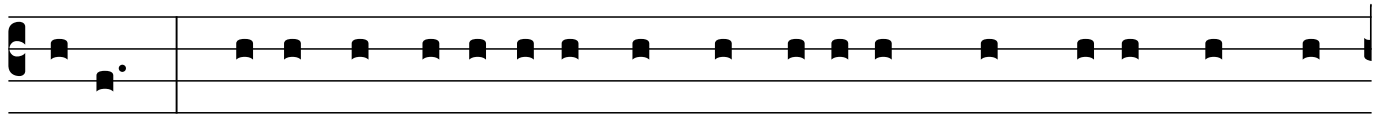
Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the



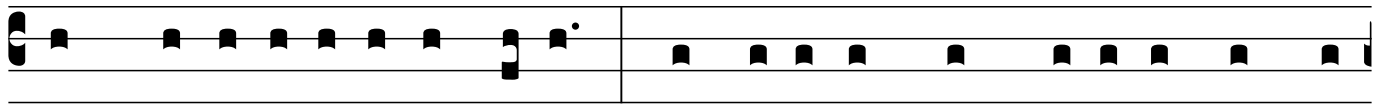
women had said, but they did not see him.” Then he said to them, “Oh, how
