


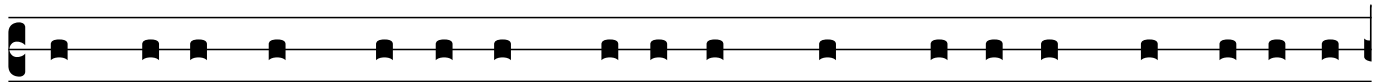
# Revelation 7:9-17

## *Burial of the Dead*

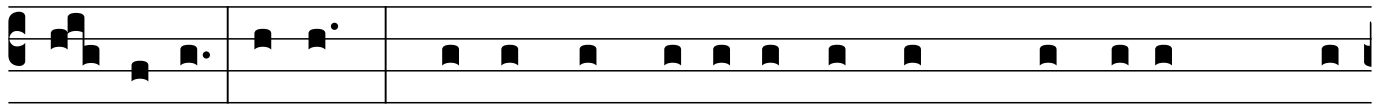

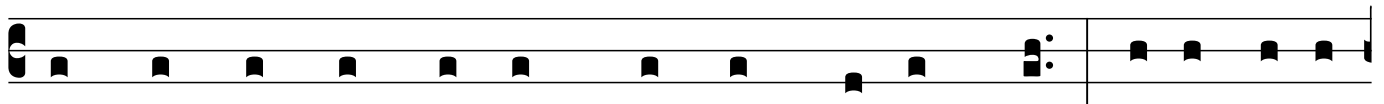

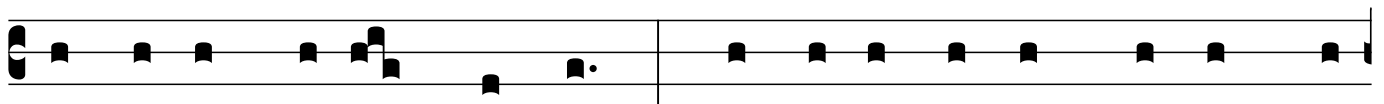
thanksgiv-ing and hon-or and power and might be to our God for-ev-er



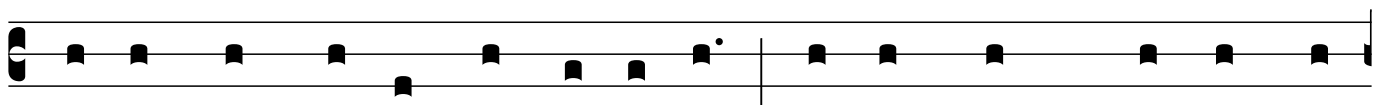
and ev-er! Amen.” Then one of the elders addressed me, say-ing, “Who



are these, robed in white, and where have they come from?” I said to him,



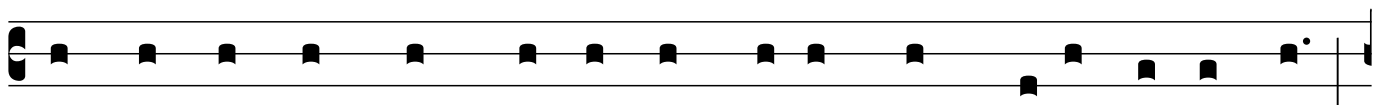
“Sir, you are the one who knows.” Then he said to me, “These are they



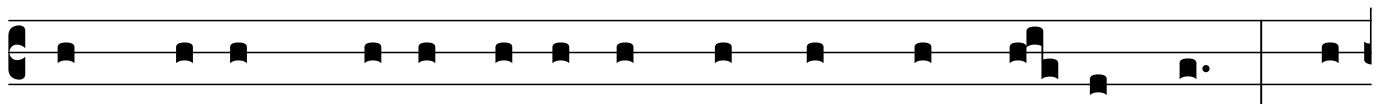
who have come out of the great ordeal; they have washed their robes and



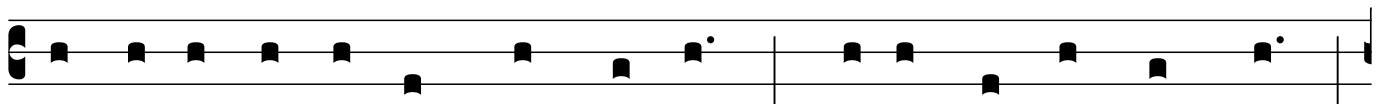
made them white in the blood of the Lamb. For this reason they are be-fore



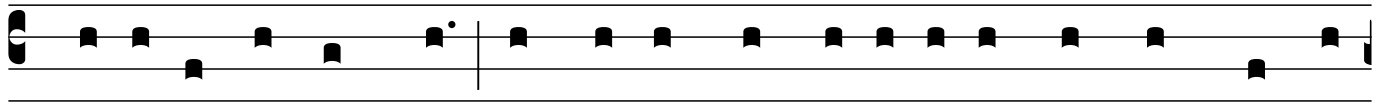
the throne of God and worship him day and night within his temple,



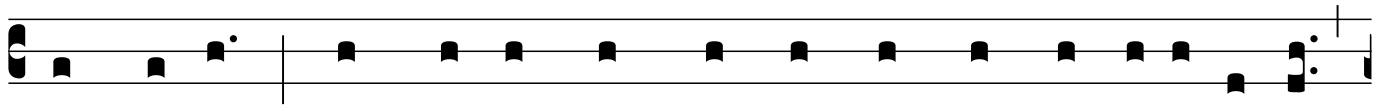
and the one who is seat-ed on the throne will shel- ter them. They



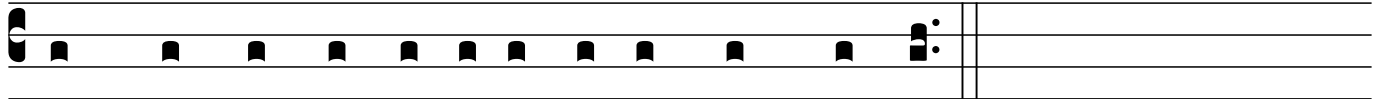
will hunger no more and thirst no more; the sun will not strike them,
